Consider Resolution 16-711, a resolution to adopt the Street Standards and Specifications Policy of 2016. Vice Mayor Duncan made a motion to approve Resolution 16-711. Commissioner Young seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote.
