Mayor Jeff Duncan called the meeting to order. Ken Castleberry introduced a new pastor in the area to the Commission, Giardo Artiega, and offered prayer. Mayor Duncan led the chambers in the pledge of allegiance.

City Recorder Allison Baker called the roll: Mayor Duncan present, Vice Mayor Tinnin present, Commissioner Anderson present, Commissioner Bell present, and Commissioner Young present.

Consider minutes of the May 28, 2020 regular meeting of the Board of Commissioners. Commissioner Young made a motion to approve the minutes as written. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion and motion passed 5-0.

City Manager Tim Ellis stated there was a letter at the Commissioner's desks from an individual building the hotel on Rivergate Parkway requesting an incentive to build a hotel and for the City to waive permitting fees. City Manager Ellis said he could not recommend this because we have not done it for the other new hotels that have come in and we do have another that is looking. City Manager Ellis stated that unless there is a request from a member of this Board for it to be put on the agenda by the next meeting, he will give them notification that it will not be considered.

Consider old business.

Consider Ordinance 20-970, an ordinance of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee adopting the annual budget for the fiscal year July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021, second reading and public hearing. Public hearing was declared open. With no one speaking in favor or against the proposed ordinance, the public hearing was declared closed. Commissioner Anderson made a motion to consider Ordinance 20-970. Vice Mayor Tinnin seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Ordinance 20-970.

Consider Ordinance 20-971, an ordinance to amend the sign regulations of the Zoning Ordinance to include defined criteria for increased interstate sign zone area based on the location of the sign, second reading and public hearing. Public hearing was declared open. With no one speaking in favor or against proposed amendment, the public hearing was declared closed. Vice Mayor Tinnin made a motion to consider Ordinance 20-971. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Ordinance 20-971.

Consider new business.

Consider Resolution 20-925, a resolution declaring certain property surplus to the needs of the City of Goodlettsville and calling for its disposal by online auction or any other manner. Commissioner Bell made a motion to consider Resolution 20-925. Commissioner Young seconded the motion. Vote was then taken which resulted in a 5-0 vote to approve Resolution 20-925.

With no further business, Commissioner Young made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Anderson seconded the motion. The meeting was adjourned at approximately 6:38 p.m. with a 5-0 vote.
