Notice is hereby given that the City Commission of the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee will hold a public hearing at 6:30 PM on Thursday, February 25, 2021 in the Massie Chambers at Goodlettsville City Hall for the purpose of discussing and hearing comments from citizens on the resolution approving the City of Goodlettsville's proposed Sumner County Urban Growth Expansion for submittal to the Sumner County Coordinating Committee per the growth boundary expansion defined by Resolution 19-872.

*City of Goodlettsville Planning Department request Goodlettsville City Commission approval to expand the Sumner County Urban Growth Boundary along Long Hollow Pike, Happy Hollow Road, and a section of Hogan's Branch Road and submittal to the Sumner County Urban Growth Boundary Coordinating Committee. The expanded growth boundary area includes both sides of Long Hollow Pike from the Ralph Hollow Road intersection to the Center Point Road and Happy Hollow Road intersection.*

The proposed plan and public hearing are being conducted pursuant to the laws of the State of Tennessee (TCA 13-7-203 and 13-7-204) and the City of Goodlettsville, Tennessee.
